



How to make Easter sock bunny

1. Fill an old, clean sock with rice (or a stuffing of your choice)— up to the beginning of the heel and loosely tie an elastic band around the heel.
2. Roughly 2/3rds of the way up the stuffing, tie a piece of string around the sock to get a snowman shape—you may need to further loosen the top elastic band.
3. Once you have your shape, tighten the top elastic band properly now as this will keep your stuffing inside.
4. To make the ears, cut the top ankle part of the sock in two, down to where your elastic band is securing the stuffing. You can then shape the ears as floppy or symmetrical as you want.
5. With a marker pen, draw 2 dots for the eyes and a cross for the nose. If using a black sock you can cut out some paper shapes and stick or sew them on for the features.
6. Personalise your bunny with whatever accessories you want—maybe an Easter ribbon neckerchief!
